Six public-at-large appointees: (2 vacancies currently)

(Vacant) Represents the unincorporated rural Area West of State Route 99 (Supervisorial District 1) with a 4-year term which began July 1, 2019.

Sal Petrucelli represents the Fresno-Clovis Metropolitan Area (Supervisorial District 2) with a 4-year term which began July 1, 2019. (Chair)

Jim Hunter represents the Fresno-Clovis Metropolitan Area (Supervisorial District 3) with a 4-year term which began July 1, 2019. He is currently semi-retired, working as a Senior Managing Consultant for Knowledge Solutions Group, Tokyo, Japan. (Co-chair)

Destiny Rodriguez represents of the incorporated cities outside of the Fresno-Clovis Metropolitan Area (Supervisorial District 4) with a 4-year term which began July 1, 2020. She currently works in Community Relations for the Center for Climate Protection.

(Vacant) represents the unincorporated rural area East of State Route 99 (Supervisorial District 5) with his second 4-year term which began July 1, 2020.

Ronald Dressler represents the Fresno-Clovis Metropolitan Area (Any Supervisorial District) with a 4-year term which began July 1, 2019. Ronald is now retired after working 50 years in the construction industry.
